

J. Josephson's Advanced Wall Protection continues to require no warning label for CA Prop 65

Based on the latest revisions to Prop 65 by the state of California in August 2018, JJ is proud to reaffirm that its Advanced Wall Protection does **not** require labeling for any listed chemical.

Background:

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.
